



CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST - NEWMARKET, ONTARIO

The position is for a full-time permanent employee and includes a comprehensive benefits package and pension plan.

Job Summary:

We are seeking a Clinical Psychologist to provide individual and group therapy within the context of a 14-week residential program, and to conduct psychological assessments. Diagnostic assessments will be conducted using standardized psychological measures and incorporate findings from the multi-disciplinary team. The Clinical psychologist will provide educational seminars and participate in weekly case reviews and staff committees. The holistic treatment model at Southdown requires close interaction with the other members of the clinical team who provide addiction services, spiritual direction, nursing, psychiatry, dietary and fitness instruction. Ongoing communication with leadership of clients through phone contact and progress letters is essential.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will have a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical Psychology or MA, C. Psych Assoc. All applicants must be eligible for registration for autonomous practice with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. Candidates who anticipate becoming supervised practice members within 12 months of their employment date with Southdown will be considered. Computer literacy is essential for purposes of electronic charting, particularly the ability to use Microsoft Office. The successful candidate will be highly organized, have exceptional written and communication skills and the ability to work independently. Individuals with experience in individual and group therapy, CBT, DBT, short term dynamic therapy, comprehensive psychological assessments, and the treatment of mood disorders and personality disorders will be given special consideration. Bilingualism in French or Spanish is an asset.
