Demonstrated competency and a minimum of three (3) years' experience in diagnosis of ASD as well as in developmental and behavioural based treatments (e.g., Joint Attention, Symbolic Play, Engagement, and Regulation (JASPER), Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA), Cognitive Behaviour Therapy(CBT)) for children and youth with ASD is ideal. Your superior communication, engagement and interpersonal skills are coupled with experience working as a member of a diverse and collaborative team.
