Psychologist (PhD)

Under the direction of the Program Manager of the Adult Rehabilitation Program, the Psychologist is responsible for the provision of clinical services to inpatients and outpatients within the program, supervision of students, as well as consultation to members of the interdisciplinary team.

Education & Experience:

A doctoral degree (eg. PhD in Clinical Psychology) from a CPA/APA accredited program. Eligibility for (and/or attainment and maintenance of) full registration with the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists including the APE designation enabling the provision of diagnoses, is required.

Relevant experience or training in a rehabilitation setting is an asset.

Demonstrated clinical assessment, treatment, and rehabilitation skills in the areas of clinical health psychology, including pain/stress management and adjustment to chronic and acquired disability. Must possess strong communication skills and the ability to collaborate effectively with an interdisciplinary team. There may be opportunities to conduct research, but this is not a requirement.
