

## **Director, Centre for Mental Health Research (CMHR) - Psychology**

The Department of Psychology at the University of Waterloo invites applications for the position of Director of the UW Centre for Mental Health Research (CMHR). The CMHR serves as a graduate training facility and research site, and is an outpatient mental health provider for the community, offering assessment and treatment for children, adolescents and adults. Our Centre strongly emphasizes the integration of science and practice. Thus we are looking for an individual who is interested in facilitating both clinical training and research, is committed to evidence based practice, who has expertise in at least one major treatment modality and whose clinical work is informed by current research. In addition to managing the daily operation of the CMHR, responsibilities for the position include teaching and supervision of graduate students in assessment and treatment of children, adolescents and/or adults, coordination of the CMHR rotation of the Waterloo Region Pre-doctoral Residency in Psychology Consortium, supervision of pre-doctoral Residents, facilitation of and participation in clinical research activities, consultation with community agencies, implementation of program initiatives, and strategic planning and development. The successful candidate must be able to work independently as well as collegially, and be able to implement, coordinate and monitor diverse research and clinical activities while fostering a constructive working environment. Candidates must have a doctorate from a CPA/APA approved program in Clinical Psychology, be registered or eligible for registration with the College of Psychologists of Ontario, and have had a minimum of four years of post-graduate experience in clinical service provision. This position will require the successful candidate to pass a comprehensive background check.
