Reporting administratively to the Program Manager, the Psychologist is responsible for offering a full range of clinical psychology services to clients with acute, and/or severe and persistent mental illnesses in a facility and/or community setting. Working as part of a multidisciplinary treatment team, the Psychologist provides assessment, treatment, and consultation services, together with collaboration with community resources to help meet the mental health needs of the individual. The Psychologist works in accordance with BGH policies and the regulations of the College of Psychologists of Ontario.

Education, Specific Training:

- Ph.D. in Psychology from an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Current Registration in good standing with the College of Psychologists of Ontario and be able to supervise student placements.
