This is a consultative (non-clinical) role involving file reviews, providing education to adjusters, working with other team members on developing parameters for monitoring and maintaining the quality of Psychological Independent Examination reports, and contributing to a dynamic work environment by identifying opportunities to improve processes, claim management, and customer service delivery. The successful candidate **will require:**

- A minimum of 2 years direct experience with administering, scoring and interpreting standardized psychological assessment instruments, including those that are commonly used to assess motor vehicle accident claimants, neuropsychological and vocational measures
- In-depth knowledge of the theory and practices of psychology, including current assessment and treatment techniques, especially those commonly utilized with claimants diagnosed with depression, anxiety, PTSD, and phobias.
- Working knowledge of relevant legislation (e.g. SABS, Minor Injury Guideline, the Psychology Act, Regulated Health Professions Act, the Personal Health Information Protection Act, the Health Care Consent Act, etc.)
- Excellent leadership and communication skills

Completed a Ph.D. in Psychology from a CPA/APA Accredited Clinical Psychology Program.

- Completed a CPA/APA accredited internship/residency (or equivalent) in clinical psychology.
