Children & Youth with Special Needs (CYSN) Generalist (Growth)

Hourly Salary: \$28.65 - \$37.83

This is a part time position (0.5 FTE, 17.5 hours bi-weekly).

The Ministry of Children and Family Development works with provincial ministry partners to build an integrated system of programs and services to support families and communities in the process of raising their children. The Ministry provides a range of services to eligible children and youth with special needs and their families.

Reporting to the Team Leader, the Child and Youth with Special Needs (CYSN) Generalist provides a combination of guardianship services to children in care of the Ministry and supports to families which include, but are not limited to: confirming eligibility of applicants for ministry funded services; supporting and enabling children and their families to access unfunded services and informal supports, as well as paid, formal supports; working with children and their families to resolve problems and create and implement plans; providing assistance to the family in building networks of support and involvement in the community and interpreting child welfare legislation.

CYSN Generalists will be required to be delegated by the Director under the Child, Family & Community Services Act (CFCSA).

Qualifications for this role include:

- Bachelors of Social Work, Masters of Social Work (MSW) or Bachelors of Arts in Child and Youth Care (BA CYC); or M.Ed. Counselling/M.A. Clinical Psychology, having completed a practicum in child and family welfare.
- At least 1 year experience (prefer recent within the last 4 years) working in social services sector with children or youth or adults with developmental disabilities, and providing support/guidance to family and/or caregiver, preference may be given to applicants with more than 1 years of experience.
- Must be able to achieve guardianship C4 delegation within 6 months.
