Applicants will participate in a variety of school and department teams and school-based team and be involved in the planning and presentation of a series of daytime and evening parent sessions and the transition process with feeder schools. In addition, the ideal candidates will have demonstrated ability and experience with adolescent issues, personal and group counselling, working with student and parent groups, liaising with community support systems, and providing peer mediation and conflict resolution. A working knowledge of post-secondary opportunities and entrance requirements is essential. Well-developed communication skills and interpersonal skills are required as collaboration with teachers and parents is crucial. School District counselling staffs work in a proactive manner with students to provide success in academic and social development. As duties include working on timetable issues and Ministry of Education graduation requirements. Applicants are expected to have excellent communication and collaboration skills with students, parents, and colleagues, as well as a demonstrated ability to plan and implement (adapting and modifying) activities to meet the needs of all individual students.

Applicants must be in good standing with the Ministry of Education - Teacher Regulation Branch and possess a professional certificate and a Master's degree in Counselling Psychology or equivalent.
