- Declared area of competency in Clinical, and Health or Rehabilitation Psychology;
- Experience in psychodiagnostic assessment and treatment of outpatients with pain conditions and co-morbid medical and psychological conditions;
- Ability to supervise/lead/coach/mentor;
- Ability to work cooperatively in an inter-professional setting;
- Experience working with word processing, spreadsheet and database applications;
- Superior written, verbal and presentation skills;
- Superior interpersonal skills;

- Proficiency in English and French – oral expression (superior level) and comprehension (superior level).

Language proficiency requirements are based on the nature of the position and the level of interaction with French- and English-speaking clients.
