



**RESIDENT IN PSYCHOLOGY

The University of New Brunswick Fredericton is seeking applications for the position of Resident in Psychology with the Department of Psychology. This is a 1 year term full-time (36.25 hours per week) position with the APT employee group. The position is funded by external monies. The salary range for this position is \$61,053 - \$85,475 per annum.

The Psychological Wellness Centre (PWC) is an externally-funded training clinic presently located in Tibbits Hall East on the University of New Brunswick (UNB) Fredericton campus. An integral part of the doctoral training program in clinical psychology at UNB, the PWC is devoted to the achievement of excellence in research, education, clinical service, and professional development, and is closely affiliated with the Psychology Department. The purpose of the PWC is to provide experiential learning opportunities in therapy and assessment to doctoral students in Clinical Psychology at a low-cost to both adults and children from Fredericton and the surrounding areas. Such services are provided within a context conducive to research, teaching, community engagement and professional development.

Position summary:

- Provide Psychological Services (e.g., assessment and therapy) to clients funded by third parties (e.g. Blue Cross, Worksafe NB, CBI, Veteran's Affairs Canada, NB Department of Social Development). The nature of the services provided will be contingent upon the skills, interests, and experience of the resident.
- Responsible for maintaining appropriate records and providing third party reports within responsible time-frames.
- Provide clinical supervision to graduate students in the doctoral program in clinical psychology.
- Develop and oversee a program of research at the PWC within their area of interest and/or in collaboration with faculty members.
- Develop and submit grant applications for research funding in keeping with such a program of research.
- Assist the director in the management of the PWC and related activities.
- Registers for Licensure within the Province of New Brunswick and completes applicable exams.

Requirements/Skills:

- Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology.
- Completion of a one-year CPA accredited predoctoral internship.
- Must be eligible to apply for Interim Membership with the College of Psychologists of New Brunswick (CPNB).
